REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR IN ART HISTORY

The minor program in Art History requires the completion of a minimum of fifteen semester hours in Art History, consisting of courses beyond the 100-level. At least one course must be taken in four or five areas of the history of art: ancient, medieval, renaissance/baroque, modern and non-western. One additional is required, and this should be selected from advanced lecture courses at the 300-500 levels, or sections of the undergraduate art history seminar (ARTH 491).

Courses taken any time during the student's career can be counted towards the minor. At the time of graduation, a student must have achieved in the minor courses a minimum G.P.A. of 2.0. A student interested in the minor program must obtain the approval of a departmental undergraduate major advisor.
