

TEACHERS

Please be sure that your students who are submitting entries to the University of Virginia Art Museum *Writer's Eye* competition follow, *exactly*, the instructions below. Failure to do so could disqualify their submissions.

Guidelines

Participant may choose to compete in either the poetry category or the prose category.

- **GRADES 3-5:**
TYPE AND SINGLE-SPACE ORIGINAL AND TWO COPIES OF YOUR POETRY OR PROSE ENTRY.

- **GRADES 6-8:**
POETRY: TYPE AND SINGLE-SPACE ORIGINAL AND THREE COPIES OF YOUR POETRY ENTRY.

PROSE: TYPE AND SINGLE-SPACE ORIGINAL AND FOUR COPIES OF YOUR PROSE ENTRY.

- **HIGH SCHOOL, UNIVERSITY AND ADULT:**
TYPE AND SINGLE-SPACE ORIGINAL AND TWO COPIES OF YOUR POETRY OR PROSE ENTRY.

All Entries:

- Type, on **All the Pages** you submit:
 - (1) The **title** of your poem or story and
 - (2) The **title** of the art work which inspired your entry

- **STAPLE** THE ENTRY FORM TO THE BACK PAGE OF THE **ORIGINAL COPY.**

- **PAPER CLIP** the original and the two, three or four copies together.

- **DO NOT** type your name on any copy. **Your name should appear only on the entry form.**

- Be sure that your entry arrives at the University of Virginia Art Museum no later than **5:00 p.m. on November 3, 2006.**
