U.Va. Faculty Exhibition Proposal

The University of Virginia Art Museum invites faculty from all areas of the University to submit applications to guest curate an exhibition in support of their research and courses.

The Museum plans its exhibition schedule, budgets and fund-raising efforts a minimum of three years in advance. Depending on the scope of the exhibition, Main Gallery exhibitions organized by faculty are possible every two to four years with a maximum of two such shows per year. Contemporary, Entrance, and Graphics Gallery exhibitions can be presented throughout each year.

The Museum's curatorial staff reviews proposals for exhibitions in January of each year. Preference is given to those exhibitions that are of aesthetic merit, advance a department's curricular mission, and are not similar to recent past exhibitions. Once an exhibition is accepted, the faculty curator is expected to participate in fund-raising efforts in addition to all aspects of the exhibition's organization. An exhibition is not confirmed until all funds are raised.
