

ELECTION OF MR. EUGENE V. FIFE TO THE MILLER CENTER
GOVERNING COUNCIL

The Miller Center Governing Council wishes to nominate Eugene V. Fife of Charlottesville to membership on the Council. The Council's next meeting will take place before the Board of Visitors meeting in April, but the Council would like to have Mr. Fife as a participating member at its forthcoming meeting. The Educational Policy Committee must approve the Miller Center's nominations to the Council and forward them to the full Board for approval.

Eugene V. Fife is a native of Hinton, West Virginia and an alumnus of Virginia Tech and the Graduate School of the University of Southern California. He has had a distinguished business career, having been a General Partner at Goldman, Sachs & Co. where he worked for over 25 years. He is the founding principal of Vawter Capital LLC, a private equity investment firm he established in Charlottesville after retiring from Goldman Sachs.

Mr. Fife has served on a number of boards and has been a member of the Medical Center Operating Board since last spring. The Miller Center proposes a term of three years for Mr. Fife on its Governing Council.
