BACKGROUND: On May 29, 2006, the University of Virginia men's lacrosse team completed a historic undefeated season by winning the NCAA championship against the University of Massachusetts, 15-7. The Cavaliers finished the season with a perfect 17-0 record in front of a championship game record crowd of 47,062 at Philadelphia's Lincoln Financial Field. The national championship is the fourth such championship in the history of the University's men's lacrosse program.
