Ms. Elstein has earned All-ACC Academic honors and is a Lawn resident. Mr. Dontrelle Inman, a third-year member of U.Va.'s football team, is a native of Batesburg, South Carolina. He is majoring in Studio Art with an emphasis on new media. Mr. Inman is a wide receiver and plays on special teams.
