Oral Interview:

(Spring) For the oral interview, you must sign up first. A sign-up sheet will be posted on the office door of B-13, New Cabell Hall, by January 9, 2007.

(Fall) For the oral interview, you must sign up first. A sign-up sheet will be posted on the office door of B-13, New Cabell Hall, by August 23, 2007.

- ❖ If you have taken Japanese in high school, summer courses, or abroad and want to continue Japanese at UVa.
- ❖ If you were brought up in Japan and studied Japanese informally and want to continue Japanese at UVa.

What Is Expected in the Test?

A two-hour written test and a five-minute oral interview.
