

KOREAN PLACEMENT TEST

When: The Korean Placement Test for Fall Semester will take place on Monday, August 25, 2008. The placement test consists of two parts: reading/writing and an oral interview. The time for the reading part starts at 10:00am and the time for an oral interview is 1:00pm-3:00pm.

Where: Room B030

Who should take a placement test?

- students who have taken Korean courses somewhere else
- students who grew up speaking or listening to Korean

What is the test?

The test has two parts: a reading/writing part and an interview. The reading/writing test is no longer than 75 minutes and an oral interview is no longer than 7 minutes. Depending on how many students there are, you may need to wait a while for your turn to take an interview.

What should you bring to the test?

Please bring TWO photo IDs, pencils, and erasers. You will not be allowed to take the test if you do not have appropriate photo IDs.

When will you know the results?

Using the last four digits of student IDs, placement test results will be posted on the Korean language bulletin board (located next to B024 in the basement of New Cabell Hall) on the day after the test.

Exemption of language requirement:

Those who wish to fulfill their language requirement can also take the placement test at the times specified above.
