

Korean Placement Test

When: The Korean Placement Test will take place on Monday, August 21, 2006. The placement test consists of two parts: reading and oral. The time for the reading part is 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and the time for the oral part is 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Where: New Cabell B030 & B031

Who should take the placement test?

Students who have studied Korean or who have had experience with Korean.

What is the test?

The test has two parts: a reading part and an interview. The reading test is no longer than 75 minutes and the oral interview is no longer than 10 minutes. Depending on how many students there are, you may need to wait quite a while for your turn to take the interview.

What should you bring to the test?

Please bring TWO photo Ids, pencils, and erasers. You will not be allowed to take the test if you don't have appropriate photo IDs.

When will you know the result?

Using the last four digits of student IDs, placement test results will be posted on the bulletin board near B027 New Cabell Hall on the day after the test at the latest.
