Now you can take advantage of the opportunities Fulbright is offering to Asia specialists in 2011-2012. These include awards in:

- **China** - projects focused on modern or pre-modern China
- **Taiwan** - projects in classical Chinese studies or on contemporary Taiwan
- **Hong Kong** - a research award and a postdoctoral research award in social sciences to turn a doctoral dissertation into a monograph or book
- **Macao** - projects in the humanities and social sciences at the Historical Archives of Macao
- **Southeast Asia** - almost all countries offer research awards
- **Japan/Korea** - awards for research in the social sciences or humanities on contemporary or historical topics
- **India and Pakistan** - welcome research projects from regional specialists and the **South and Central Asia Regional Research Program** makes it possible to do research in two or more countries
