## Scholarship Announcement

Dear College Administrator,

- Be legally authorized to work in the United States without sponsorship now or in the future.

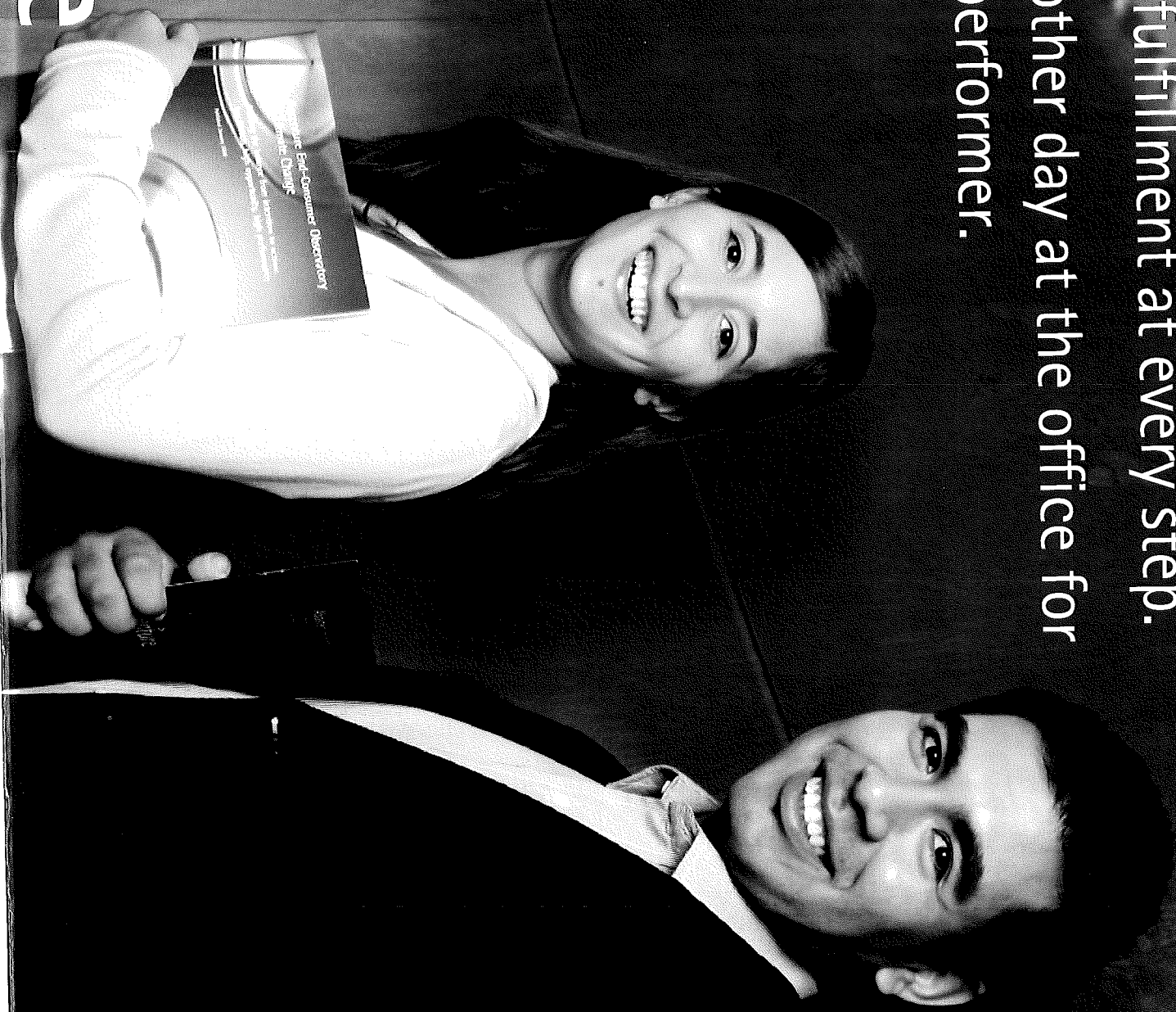
