Dear Sir or Madam:

The American Society of Naval Engineers (ASNE) sponsors a scholarship program to encourage students to enter the field of naval engineering and to provide support to naval engineers seeking advanced education in the field. Programs of study which apply to the diverse field of naval engineering include naval architecture, marine, mechanical, civil, aeronautical, electrical and electronic engineering, and the physical sciences. Other programs leading to careers with both military and civilian organizations requiring these educational backgrounds are also included.

Scholarship awards of \$3,000 for undergraduate students and \$4,000 for graduate students will be made for the 2007 - 2008 academic year. The candidate must be a U.S. Citizen and **demonstrate a genuine interest in a career in naval engineering**. These scholarships apply only to the last year of a full-time or co-op undergraduate program or to one year of graduate study leading to a designated degree in an accredited college or university. Graduate student candidates must be ASNE members. They may join ASNE when applying. Scholarship information and applications are available on our web site at www.navalengineers.org under "Scholarships".

SCHOLARSHIPS

- Amount of Award:** \$3,000 per year for undergraduate student; \$4,000 per year for graduate student
- Who is Eligible:** Candidate will be applying for either the last year of a full-time or co-op undergraduate program or one year of graduate study leading to a designated engineering degree or physical science degree at an accredited college or university. A scholarship will not be awarded to a doctoral candidate or to a person already having an advanced degree.
- Candidate must be a United States citizen.
- Candidate must have demonstrated or expressed a genuine interest in a career in Naval Engineering, e.g. activity in a professional engineering society and extra-curricular engineering activities.
- Graduate student candidate must be a member of ASNE or SNAME.
- Selection Criteria:** Candidate's academic record, work history, professional promise, interest in Naval Engineering, extra-curricular activities, and recommendations of college faculty, employers, and other character references. Financial need may also be considered.
- Some of the Programs of study that applies:** Naval Architecture, Marine, Ocean, Mechanical, Civil, Aeronautical, Electrical, and Electronic Engineering, the Physical Sciences, as well as other programs leading to careers with both the military and civilian organizations requiring these educational backgrounds.
