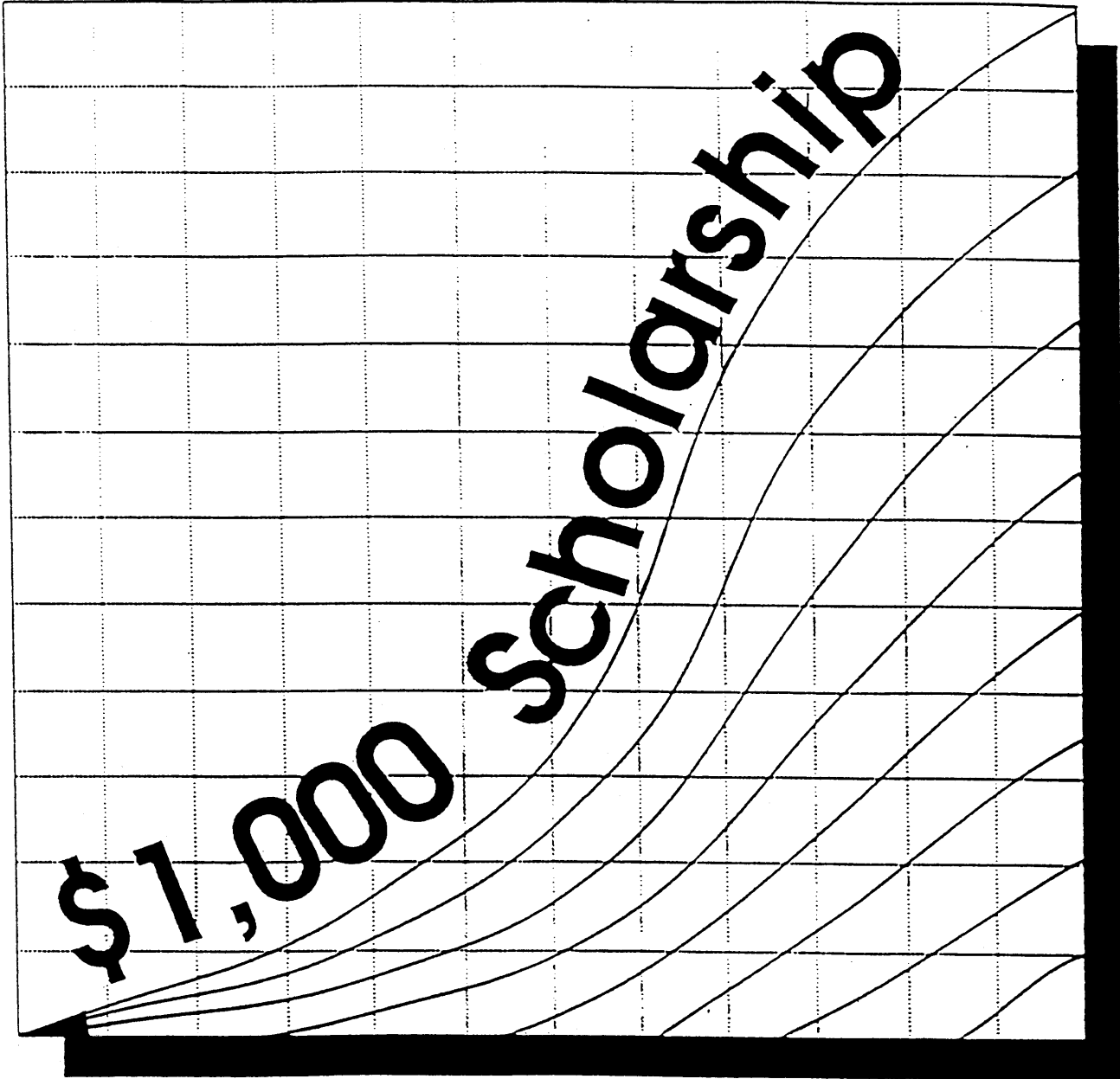

2007-2008 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM***

The Virginia Council of Teachers of Mathematics (VCTM) encourages those persons interested in becoming teachers of mathematics by offering at least one scholarship of \$1,000 annually. VCTM's objective in establishing this program is to unite the efforts of its members who seek to improve the teaching of mathematics. For the past four years, the VCTM Board of Directors has authorized that two scholarships may be awarded if qualified applicants are judged deserving by the current members of the Scholarship Committee.

DESCRIPTION

Students applying for this year's scholarship must be full-time students who are Virginia residents, **graduating in Summer 2007 or Fall 2007, or in Spring 2008** with a major in mathematics, and planning to teach mathematics in a Virginia school. Applicants planning to teach at elementary, middle school, high school, and college levels all are eligible, including students in a program leading to a mathematics lead teacher or mathematics specialist. Completed application materials must be returned postmarked no later than January 1, 2007, to be followed by an official transcript showing grades through the Fall 2006 term, postmarked no later than January 15, 2007.

The scholarship winner(s) will be announced at VCTM's 29th Annual Conference during the weekend of March 9-10, 2007, at the Virginia Beach Resort and Conference Center. All applicants will be notified in writing of the Committee's decision.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Selection will be based on the applicant's potential for a successful career teaching mathematics, as indicated by scholastic records, recommendations of two faculty members, and the applicant's narrative statement. All applications will be reviewed by and the winner selected by VCTM's Scholarship Committee, with approval of VCTM's Executive Officers.

RECENT WINNERS

Last May, Kathryn (Katie) Massey of Virginia Tech and Samantha Soukup of Longwood University were selected for the scholarships. In 2005, the winners were Alisa R. Mook of VA Tech and Allena Monique Poles of VA Union Univ. . 2004's winners were Robyn L. Brewster of Bluefield College, and Jennifer McLaughlin of Virginia Tech. In the Spring of 2003, Amy Tribble of James Madison University, and Christy Lowery of Averett University were chosen for the scholarships. Melissa E. Andersen, a mathematics major at Mary Washington College, was selected as the recipient of the 2002 Scholarship. In 2001, the winner was Kristy Banton, of Virginia Commonwealth University. Katherine M. Sutphin of Mary Washington College received the scholarship in 2000. The winners of the 1999 scholarship were Dana N. Daniels, of Longwood College, and Tiana M. Taylor, of Averett College. In 1998, the winner was Jonathan Covell, of James Madison University. In 1997, scholarships were awarded to Sarah E. Boyer from Mary Washington College, and Katherine Elms from Virginia Tech. Winners of 1996 scholarships were Jennifer Annis from the University of Virginia and Arun Nava from VPI and State University.
