The Gamma Alpha Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma Society International is pleased to offer a scholarship award to a female student pursuing a career in education. One of the purposes of this international organization, which unites outstanding female educators, is to help individuals pursue their studies.

The value of the scholarship is \$2,000 to be paid to the college or university of the award recipient in \$1000 increments over two years.

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- female, pursuing a teaching career
- rising junior, enrolled in the School of Education / Education Department
- permanent resident of either Hanover, Henrico, King William, New Kent, Louisa, Goochland, or Charles City County or the City of Richmond
- minimum 3.25 GPA

Procedures for the application and payment are as follows:

- The application packet must be submitted via email to gammalpha@live.com no later than midnight on **March 31, 2010**. A copy of the information and application may be found at <http://deltakappagamma.org/VA-gammaalpha>
- The email should have the following items attached:
 - the completed application form
 - three of the five possible written essays
 - an unofficial transcript

Please note that the winning candidate will be required to submit an official transcript before funds will be released.

- Applicants will be notified by April 9, 2010.
- In the fall semester of 2010 and 2011 a check in the amount of \$1000 will be sent to the college/university registrar to be credited to the recipient's account.
- In the fall of 2010, the recipient will be a guest at one of the Gamma Alpha meetings to share her winning essays.
