SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION & APPLICATION CRITERIA

REQUIREMENTS:

- Enrolled in an engineering (any discipline) or architecture program leading to a bachelor's degree or equivalent.
- Undergraduate class standing of sophomore, junior or senior as of the Spring 2008 semester
- Attending a Virginia university or college, or dependent of a Va. Peninsula Post member enrolled elsewhere

SELECTION BASED ON THE FOLLOWING (provide a brief paragraph for each):

- Academic standing – current combined GPA, honor societies, awards, etc.
- Involvement in university activities
- Involvement community programs
- Demonstrated commitment to future military service by enrollment in a ROTC program, a commissioning program, or an extended enlistment
- Financial need - how education costs are being met--other scholarships, loans, jobs, etc.

AWARDS:

- One-time \$500 to \$1,500 scholarship (amount will be determined on need and qualifications)
- One year student membership in SAME

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Statement of activities and need from applicant (two (2) pages of single-spaced text maximum, 12 point text minimum size addressing the items above)
- Letter of recommendation from school official w/ contact information
- Copy of applicant's current transcript
