Independence Seaport Museum is pleased to offer the Vaughan Family Maritime Scholarship. Grants of \$2,000 are available to persons demonstrating financial need and researching for publication on subjects involving wooden sailing ships or wooden steamboats, or working toward a graduate degree in a related field of study.

Applicants are welcome to use the Museum's collections in their research but are not required to do so. Access to our object collections and library is available by appointment.

Funding recipients will be asked for a copy of your article, book or thesis to add to our library.

To apply, please send:

- A letter of not more than three, single-spaced pages describing yourself and your project. Please use 12pt or larger type. Tell us the title of your project and how it will contribute to understanding of your topic. Describe the product of your work (article, thesis, book, etc.). Briefly explain your financial need. Please include your address, telephone number, and email address.
- Your C.V. (not to exceed three pages).
- Two letters of reference. Graduate students should include their thesis advisor.

Applications and all attachments must be postmarked no later than November 15, 2006. Notification of awards will be sent in December.
