

## Adjustment Reason Codes and Descriptions

| Adjustment Code | Description  |
|-----------------|--|
| 001             | Your financial aid award has been either increased or decreased based upon the review of additional documentation that you supplied.   |
| 002             | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to other sources of funding that have become available to you, such as an outside scholarship or a Department award.  |
| 003             | Your financial aid award has been reduced to a one-term award because your aid was initially awarded based on a full year's attendance, but you are only attending for 1 term (e.g. December graduation, transfer to another school, suspension) |
| 004             | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to withdrawal from the University during the course of a term.  |
| 005             | Your financial aid award has undergone a one-time adjustment due to a request for a budget increase for a computer purchase. Note that this increase is to your loan eligibility only, and does not count toward the UVA loan cap.               |
| 006             | Your financial aid award has undergone an adjustment due to a request for a budget increase for health insurance. Note that this increase is to loan eligibility only, and may count toward the UVA loan cap if the loan is subsidized.          |
| 007             | Your aid has been adjusted because you were initially awarded as living on-Grounds or off-Grounds, but further review shows you are living with your parents.  |
| 008             | Your financial aid has been adjusted because You have been approved by your department for part-time enrollment, which reduces your tuition and overall cost of attendance.  |
| 009             | Your financial aid award has been either increased because you now meet standards for Satisfactory Academic Progress or canceled because you no longer meet standards for Satisfactory Academic Progress.  |
| 010             | Your financial aid award has been adjusted because you 1) failed to accept your January Term loan, 2) declined your January Term loan, or 3) changed your January Term enrollment status.  |
| 011             | Your financial aid award has been adjusted because you enrolled in Fall or Spring Study Abroad or Semester at Sea after your Official financial aid award was determined.  |
| 012             | Your financial aid award has been adjusted because you 1) failed to accept your Summer Term loan, 2) declined your Summer Term loan, or 3) changed your Summer Term enrollment status.   |
| 013             | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to a change in your grade level by the Office of the University Registrar (i.e., you are now a third year instead of a second year)   |
| 014             | Your financial aid award has been decreased because the lender-approved amount for your Direct PLUS or Graduate PLUS loan is less than the amount originally requested and originated by Student Financial Services.                             |
| 015             | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to a proration of your loan(s). This is an adjustment typically associated with students in their final term at the University who are registered for fewer than 15 credit hours.                 |
| 016             | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to the fact that the lender   |

|     | disbursed your loan in an amount different from what was originally anticipated.   |
| 017 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to a change in the origination fee amount for your loan.  |
| 019 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted to reflect the denial of your Direct PLUS or Graduate PLUS loan application, which was initially part of your financial aid award.  |
| 020 | Your financial aid award's unsubsidized loan portion has been increased due to a denial of your Direct PLUS loan application   |
| 021 | Your financial aid award has been modified due to an administrative error.   |
| 022 | Your financial aid award has had an ACG/SMART award added to it, and there may be a corresponding reduction in other components of your award as a result.   |
| 023 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted because the number of hours for which you are enrolled fail to meet requirements for Pell, ACG, SMART, or TEACH. There is likely to be a corresponding increase in your institutional aid as a result.  |
| 024 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted according to your request.  |
| 026 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to a change in your residency status made by the Office of Virginia Status, (434) 982-3391.   |
| 027 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to a change to your Grant-in-Aid (GIA).   |
| 028 | Your financial aid award has been increased or decreased due to changes in your Veterans benefits or military benefits.  |
| 029 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted because you have reached your UVa loan cap. As a result, your institutional funding has been increased.   |
| 030 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to the awarding of a TEACH grant.   |
| 031 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to the reissuing of a loan.   |
| 032 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to a change in your expected enrollment status. This is typically the result of your award being based upon enrollment full-time in for-credit hours, but your actual enrollment is a blend of for-credit and non-topical research hours or all non-topical research hours.                   |
| 033 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to a Departmental award.  |
| 034 | Your loan has been cancelled due to failure to sign your promissory note or failure to complete entrance counseling.   |
| 035 | Your loan has been cancelled because it was never accepted and the period of eligibility for the loan has passed. At this point, you may apply for a private loan, and instructions for how to do so can be found at <a href="http://www.virginia.edu/financialaid/loans10_11.php">http://www.virginia.edu/financialaid/loans10_11.php</a> . |
| 036 | Your financial aid award has been adjusted due to a change in permanent residency status that impacts scholarship and/or grant eligibility.  |
