Additional Information:

- There are no restrictions placed on tuition and fee increases.
- The state match on the Eminent Scholars program was completely eliminated. This represents a reduction of approximately \$2.8 million, which is in addition to the \$23 million described above.
- Two UVa capital projects will be delayed: New Cabell Hall Renovation and Ruffner Hall Renovation.
- There will be no salary increases funded in 2009-2010 making two fiscal years in which there are no salary increases.
- UVa receives none of the \$26 million in additional funding included in the Governor's proposed budget for need-based financial aid.
- The Equipment Trust Fund remains at approximately \$10 million.
- Maintenance Reserve funding remains at nearly \$7.5 million in 2009-2010 (\$15 million for the biennium).
- UVa received a technical adjustment (increase) of \$1.1 million for employer healthcare premiums. This is routine and provides funding for our program comparable to what is provided to other state agencies.
- Research funding was reduced by 8% but not eliminated.
- Proposals to limit the cost of Medicaid could reduce UVa Medical Center revenues by as much as \$3.3 million.
