

# HISTORY DMP APPLICATION 2008

An application consists of two parts: (1) Basic information about you which you must supply; (2) Material that you must submit. Completed applications must be submitted to Professor Lenard R. Berlanstein by Wednesday March 26 by 4:00 p.m. (Leave the application in Berlanstein's mailbox in Randall Hall 103).

## Part Two, Supporting Documents:

1. An unofficial TRANSCRIPT (not VISTAA form) covering all work at UVA and all other college work.
  2. A sample of your written work. Ideally this sample should come from a history course. Typically samples run ca. five pages.
  3. A short statement (3-4 pages.) about why you want to write a substantial research paper (thesis) as part of your history major. Discuss why you believe that you are qualified to take on this ambitious task. It is not expected that you will have a well-developed research topic right now, but indicate if you can the area of history (for example, medieval France, modern Middle East, American Civil War) in which you will probably write your thesis.
  4. State below the NAME and EMAIL ADDRESS an instructor (preferably a regular faculty member, but a Teaching Assistant if necessary) who can attest to your qualifications for the DMP. Do not ask this person to write a letter of reference for you. We will contact the instructor on a case by case basis.
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
