Please feel free to attach additional supporting materials, especially those available in electronic form. Letters of support from others familiar with the nominated individual or organization are encouraged, but please limit to no more than 2 letters of support.

Submit the nomination package (this completed form and any supporting materials) electronically to cwilk@virginia.edu by March 17, 2006 for consideration by the Award Committee.

The Committee will notify the recipient by April 21, 2006. The Award will be presented at the 2006 Virginia Natural Resources Leadership Institute's Graduation on June 1, 2006 in Charlottesville.
