

**University of Virginia Intramural Sports**  
**3-Point Shootout**

Each player must present a valid UVA student ID or current Recreation Membership Card and photo ID before each contest to be eligible to participate - no exceptions! All players must have checked in with an Intramural Supervisor before they are allowed to participate. Game time is forfeit time.

All Intramural participants are responsible for their own medical expenses. Any participant unsure of his/her physical condition should check with their family physician or the Elson Student Health Center before participating in an Intramural Sports contest.

The Intramural Supervisors shall have the power to make decisions on any matters or questions not specifically covered in the following rules:

1. Each participant will get 5 shots at 5 different stations around the 3-point line (25 total shots). The first 4 balls on each rack are worth 1 point each. The last ball on each rack is worth 2 points (the money ball!). There will be a 60-second time limit in effect.
2. Participants who accumulate 15 points or more will advance to the second round. The three participants with the highest combined scores after 2 rounds will have the opportunity to shoot at halftime of a UVa Basketball game to determine the champion.

Women: UVa vs. Boston College. Sunday 2/22 at 5pm

Men: UVa vs. Miami. Thursday 2/26 at 8pm

3. Participants may only shoot once.
