

## Issues with Customized SIS pages

- If users customize their SIS pages, they may experience issues with that page after the bundle upgrades.
- SIS users can go to about any page in SIS and change the default setting for that page by clicking the Customize Page link.

### Page Customization


- Put this page in front (the current tab) when I come into this component.
