




My Academics: Academic Requirements

The “My Academics” tab, within the class search section, gives you access to overviews of your studies. You can view your advisement report and “what-if” scenarios. You may also view your transfer credits, course history, transcript, and apply for graduation. Many of these functions are also available through the main Student Center page.
