Student Council Appropriations Process	The Student Council Appropriations Committee allocates the Student Activity Fee collected from all students at the University, amounting to approximately \$600,000. There is a Fall and Spring Appropriations Process.	Any approved CIO can and is encouraged to participate in the Appropriations Process. The Appropriations Committee will look at the submitted budget for the organization.	The Rolling Process begins a month or so into the first semester and continues for the entire academic year. The Annualized Process begins at the beginning of the second semester. Approved CIOs will receive notification via e-mail.	All participating groups must attend a mandatory meeting and will be informed of the steps of the process at that point.
