

Event Rules

"Scramble" means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.

The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Then, each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.

This procedure is repeated every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.

Putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.

If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you may not drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.

Etiquette

Please smooth all marks made in Sand Bunkers.

Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out.

Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range.

Balls may be cleaned on the green, and ball marks repaired prior to putting. You may not repair spike marks prior to putting.

Please observe all local course rules.
