Time to Program Completion

*****Note:** We calculate time to program completion based on *final graduation date*. This occurs after the internship year, and in many cases as much as 9 months after all requirements including internship are completed, as students often wait to graduate in university ceremonies the following May.

*****Note on student breakdown of statistics below:** All statistics reported below are for students entering the program with a BA or BS. No students from 2004-2011 entered the program with an MA or MS.

Thus actual time spent in residence, excluding internship on average is approximately 1 ½ years less than the numbers below.

Program Costs

All students in good standing are guaranteed that all tuition costs will be covered (including costs for student health insurance) for the first 4 years in the program. In addition, as of Spring 2010, all students in their first 4 years have been guaranteed a *minimum* of \$16,000/year for the nine-month academic year.

In the past decade all students have received full funding through their first 5 years, and the majority beyond that as well.

If students do not receive funding after year 4, costs are: \$1,774 in tuition and insurance per semester, plus \$2,152 in mandatory health insurance for the year.

We have a 100% success rate in placing students in internships over the past 7 years:

Licensure

Of the 31 graduates of the program between 2000 and 2008, 19 (61%) are currently licensed and 3 (10%) are in the process of obtaining their licenses. Non-licensed students are typically in either academic or institutional settings where licensure is not a requirement for their job/career direction.
