| _____ 1) Bayh-Dole Act | a) requires that each Agency make available certain information to the public in the Federal Register |
| _____ 2) Davis-Bacon | b) for contracts >\$2K it is unlawful to induce, by force, intimidation, threat of procuring dismissal from employment or otherwise, any person employed in the construction or repair of public buildings or works financed by the govern. |
| _____ 3) Solomon Amendment | c) allows the President to propose to Congress that funds be rescinded |
| _____ 4) Contract Work Hours & Safety Act | d) restricts the purchase of supplies that are not domestic end products |
| _____ 5) Buckley Amendment | e) established to protect persons from invasions of personal information |
| _____ 6) Freedom of Information Act | f) non U.S. firms selling below cost price on the U.S. can be fined – fines are then given to the U.S. companies making the complaint and suffering a loss |
| _____ 7) Walsh-Healey | g) contractors for Fed. projects (>\$2K) must pay no less than the prevailing wage in the local area for each craft utilized as determined by the US Dept. of Labor |
| _____ 8) Toxic Substance Control Act | h) established the Small Business Administration to aid & assist small businesses under the Dept. of Commerce |
| _____ 9) Copeland Act | i) requires that when issuing statements, press releases, RFP, bid solicitations, etc. shall clearly state total costs of the project, \$ supported from Federal funds |
| _____ 10) Byrd Amendment | j) denies certain Federal funds to institutions that prohibits or prevents the Secretary of Defense from recruiting on campus or having access to students |

or from having access to directory information for students

- _____ 11) Debarment & Suspension k) agree to fly US flag air carries to, from, between or within a country when a U.S. flag air carrier is available
- _____ 12) Drug-Free Workplace l) allows for transfer of exclusive control over inventions to universities
- _____ 13) Fair Labor Standards Act m) established a minimum hourly wage, overtime pay and regulates child labor
- _____ 14) Fly America Act n) characterize & evaluate the risks posed by chemicals to humans & the environment before being introduced into commerce
- _____ 15) Buy American Act o) requires that student educational records be released & available to parents
- _____ 16) Patriot Act p) requires applicants of Federal funds to certify that neither they, their principals, nor their researchers are presently banned by any Federal agency
- _____ 17) Impound Control Act q) employers furnishing the government with materials/supplies or equipment under contracts >\$100,000 must pay the prevailing minimum wage for straight time hours and pay 1 ½ times for work >40 hours while maintaining sanitary & non-hazardous working conditions
- _____ 18) Privacy Act of 1974 r) requires that overtime pay be given for any hours > 40 in a workweek
- _____ 19) Stevens Amendment s) requires both individuals and institutions to not produce, acquire, retain, or possess types & quantities of any biological materials
- _____ 20) Small Business Act t) denies federal funding from any institutions that do not have a drug-free workplace policy – for all contracts of \$25,000 or more
