### Choose *one* application format:

We *strongly recommend* that you apply online. The online application consolidates the application process, enables you to see when application materials have been received by our office, and allows you to view your admission decision online the day that we mail decision letters. Please visit the Office of Admission Web site listed above and click Apply Now for further instructions.

If you use a paper application, follow the instructions below. Please type or print in dark ink and make copies to keep for your own records. Once you submit Part 1 of this booklet with your \$60.00 application fee, you must continue to submit paper forms.

### Choose *one* undergraduate school:

You must apply to one undergraduate school. If you do not choose a school, we will automatically consider you for the College of Arts & Sciences. For further information, please refer to the *Prospectus*. Please note that we are not able to honor requests to switch schools after March 1. Admitted students should plan to enroll in the school to which they have applied.

### Choose when to apply:

First Year: January 2, 2008

January Transfer: November 1, 2007

August Transfer: March 1, 2008

### Recommendations:

You must submit a recommendation from your school; usually a guidance counselor writes this recommendation and includes it with the School and Transcript Report (Part 3). We do not provide a separate recommendation form.

We also encourage you to submit an additional recommendation. Recommendations must be submitted

either with the School and Transcript Report or with the Supplement for First-Year Applicants. We cannot guarantee that recommendations submitted in another manner will be filed before we evaluate your application.

### Arts Supplement Evaluations:

If you are exceptionally talented in art, music, dance, or drama, we urge you to send a sample of your work. Portfolios must be submitted by the appropriate postmark deadline of December 1 for all first-year applicants. Transfer applicants should submit their supplements by March 1, 2008. Submissions *must* have the indicated postmark deadline or they will not be reviewed. Because we cannot return your submissions, be sure to send a copy, not an original. Please use the labels that are included with the printed application or print the labels from the Admission Office Web site. All supplements *must* have appropriate labeling. Please note that architecture portfolios will not be evaluated.

## The Honor System

Students at the University make a commitment not to lie, cheat, or steal within Charlottesville, Albemarle County, or where they represent themselves as University students in order to gain the trust of others. Because they have made this commitment, students are trusted by peers, faculty members, administrators, and community residents alike. Students conduct themselves with integrity and are presumed honorable until proven otherwise.

Students are recruited and trained by the Honor Committee to serve as advisers and to provide counsel. Students investigate Honor allegations, assist and support accused students through the Honor process, and work with accused students in their defense at trial. Honor jury panels are similarly comprised entirely of students. While anyone may report Honor proceedings, the process is administered entirely by students.

The vitality of the Honor System depends upon the willingness of students to uphold the high standards set by their peers. When a student is formally accused of an Honor offense following investigation, that student may elect to either (1) leave the University, without requesting a trial (in which case that student will be deemed to have admitted guilt, whether or not such an admission is expressly made), or (2) request an Honor trial. Any student found guilty of an Honor offense, or deemed

to have admitted guilt after having left without requesting a trial, will be permanently dismissed from the University. The notation "enrollment discontinued" will be placed on the student's transcript, without specific reference to the Honor proceedings. In the case of a student

found guilty of an Honor offense following graduation, or deemed to have admitted guilt without requesting a trial after graduation, the General Faculty of the University may undertake proceedings to revoke that student's degree. The rules of the Honor System apply to any person who was a University student at the time an alleged Honor offense was committed, so long as a case is reported within two years thereafter.

Students who enroll at the University benefit from the freedom and security provided by the Honor System; every student must agree to live by and support the spirit of honor. Applicants who are not prepared to embrace this freedom and accept this responsibility should not apply for admission.
