Please carefully read the following information about your stay at UVa during Spring Blast:

DAYS ON THE LAWN: Spring Blast activities coincide with Days on the Lawn. You should receive a detailed schedule of the Days on the Lawn activities in the mail. You do not have to register for the April 18th Days on the Lawn if you register for Spring Blast.

HOSTING ARRANGEMENTS:

If you plan to participate in the student host program (this means the Admission Office will assign you an overnight host) please register no later than **Friday, April 11th**. We will contact you **via email** with your host assignment as soon as the information is available. **Contact your host once you receive his/her information.** Your host may be reassigned if you do not contact him/her prior to your arrival. If you are staying with an independent host, it is your responsibility to contact him/her. Your host will specify what you need to bring for sleeping arrangements.

VERY IMPORTANT!! A PARENT INFORMATION STATEMENT must be signed and turned in at check-in before you can stay in the dorms with your assigned host. You will not be able to stay in the dorms without this signed statement.

The Admission's portion of Spring Blast officially ends at 5pm on Saturday, April 20th. Please be aware that the Office of Admission makes hosting arrangements only for one night (Friday).
